Number the pictures in the order in which they happened.

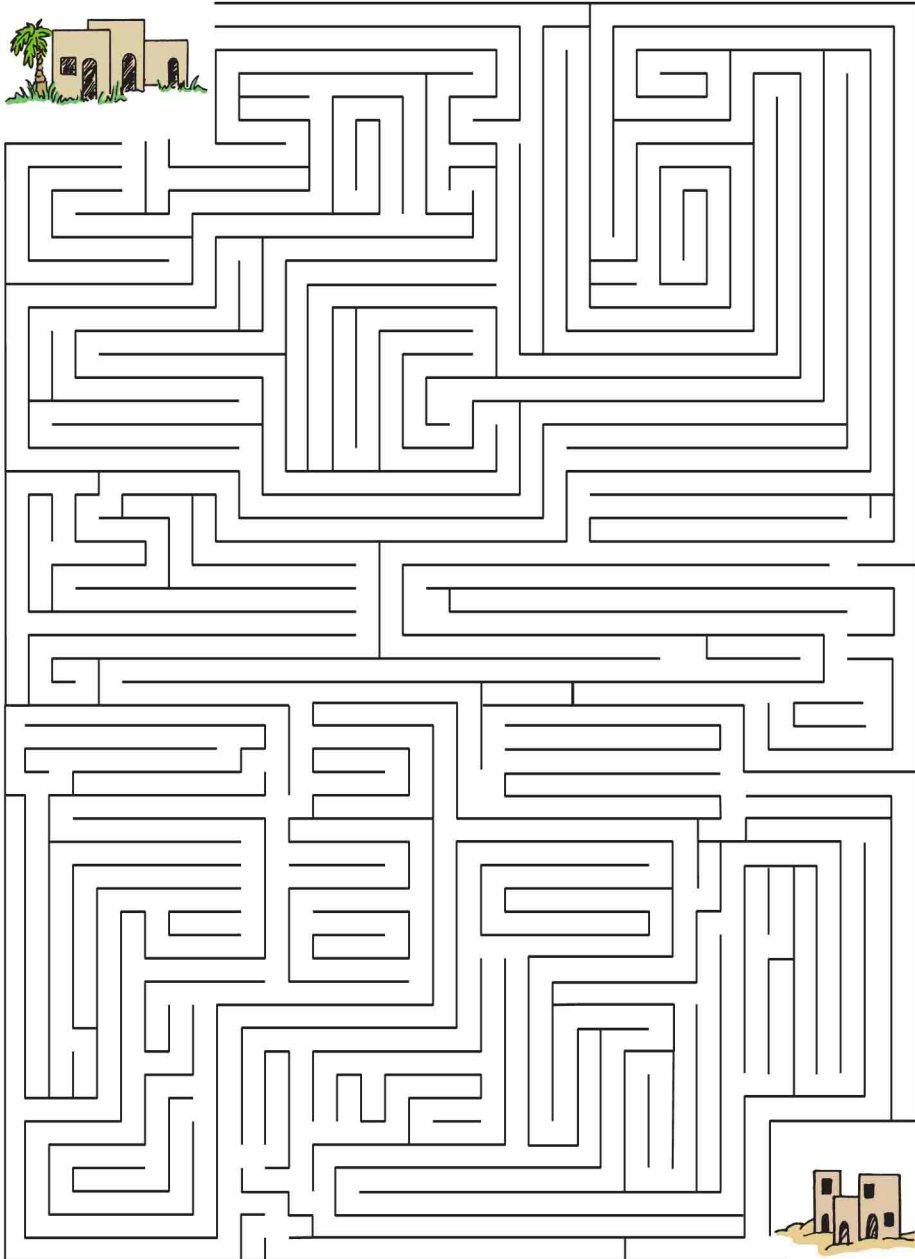


* A tanner treats animal hides to make leather.

When a woman named Tabitha died in the nearby town of Joppa, the Christians sent for Peter.

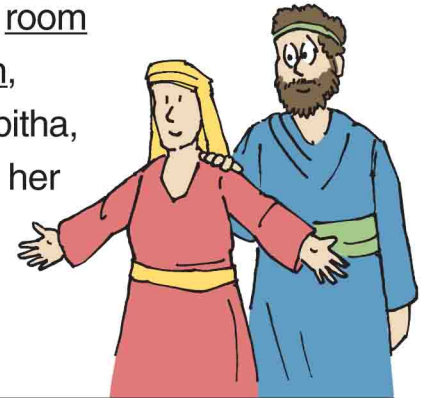
Follow the maze from Lydda to Joppa.
